The Morrish Road Bridge Project is out to bid with returns due back last week. Incorporated into the design are the non-participating enhancements as well as the road closure for construction. The project is estimated to last for two months and with a tentative start date of June 17th. The first round of notification letters went out last week with additional letters planned later into the spring.

On a related matter, the four year TIP call for project applications are due late this month. Staff meetings with our engineer are suggesting that we put all of Miller Road between Seymour and Dye in, as well as the Bristol Road cuts in front of GM-SPO, the corresponding sections of Bristol Road, Fairchild Street and Winston Streets. This should just about take care of our major streets for a little while. Here are tentative dates that Mike Royalty has set for the application package:

As discussed at the meeting of July 23rd, we are in Circuit Court for quiet title acquisition with a default judgment scheduled to be heard on January 28th. There have been no challenges to the action so the courts endorsement should be a matter of formality. We can finish the closing right afterwards. Pursuant to the agreements, the building has been demolished and the underground tanks removed.

✓ PERSONNEL & POLICIES & PROCEDURES (Status) Pending.

✓ CITY PROPERTY, 4438 MORRISH ROAD (Status)

We'll look at a disposition for the house at 4438 Morrish in the spring.

✓ LABOR CONTRACTS, SHARED SERVICES, BUILDING DEPARTMENT (Status)

The POLC, AFSCME, Supervisor, Assessor, Zoning Administrator and Part-Time Police Officers have been settled. The remaining loose ends are the building inspector's employment agreement, which in part is addressed in the Shared Services Study and the City Manager contract. We'll be visiting these issues after the first of the year. The shared services committee continues to meet and should have a report back to the Council soon.

✓ FIRE DEPARTMENT: BUDGET, CONTRACT & COST RECOVERY (Status)

The Township and Fire Board has asked to meet. I'll keep the Council posted on new developments.

✓ SPRINGBROOK EAST & HERITAGE ASSOCIATION S.A.D. (Status)

All that remains is to accept the streets into our Act #51 Street System. This process is a bit lengthy insofar as legal steps required assuring a proper transfer. Mr. Figura has prepared the paperwork on this end. There are several steps the Associations need to complete before we can begin our process. As soon as we get past this busy spurt, I'll fire up the Associations to start the process.

✓ SIGN ORDINANCE, APPENDIX A REVISIONS (Status)

The Planning Commission, at their January 8th meeting, discussed changes to the Sign Ordinance as well as design standard changes in Appendix A. They held the required public hearing and approved the recommendation for changes to both. The matter is in to the City Attorney for proper formatting and should be back to the Council for final consideration in the near future.

✓ SCHOOL PERFORMING ARTS CENTER (Status)

Outside work is mostly completed. For the time being, I'll drop this from the radar. As other associated matters arise, I'll bring them back.

✓ MEIJER SITE PLAN, INTERSTATE TRAFFIC SIGNAL (Status)

The Council approved an amended site plan allowing for the construction of a gross square foot store of 192,214 along with related changes to parking, traffic circulation, lighting, landscaping, and signage, all of which have been deemed by the City's staff as minor and within the general concept of the original site plan approval. On paid-in capital, Meijer funded improvements capped at \$1,500,000. To date, they have paid \$1,095,000. They owe the City \$52,873, which when invoiced and paid, will put their contribution, to date, for the Morrish project at \$1,147,873. This leaves \$352,127 left to fund traffic signals and other related improvements. Shop drawings for the traffic light are complete and have been submitted to MDOT for approval. Specifications were in strict adherence to MDOT standards, so approval should not be an issue. In the interest of stack time (which is beginning to run very slim), we ordered the steel from the only source in the state, Carrier & Gable Inc., of Farmington Hills. The matter will go to bid by Progressive AE very shortly. Rockford Construction tells me they have a scheduled contract release to Meijer Inc. in March. After this, it'll be up to corporate as to an opening date.

✓ ADOPT FIVE-YEAR PARKS & RECREATION PLAN (Resolution)

A final draft of the plan, as recommended by the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board, is included on tonight's CD. I also have a resolution of adoption. The Parks & Recreation Advisory Board should be commended for the time and effort they put into this plan.

As we discussed at the July 23rd Meeting, we have lease agreements with Tri-County Wireless, an internet provider, for the location of a transceiver on top of the water tower at Miller & Seymour. The lease is scheduled to expire this month and Tri-county requests to renew it. They are paid up in good standing. I'm proceeding with a contract renewal based on our disinterest in WI-FI service. I should have something back within the next meeting or two for approval.

- ✓ CITY WEB SITE, RELATED SERVICES (Status)
 - Up and running without error. The feedback has all been positive.
- ✓ MPSC COMPLAINT, FRONTIER v CITY (Status)

Right of way permit has been issued. I have a scheduled meeting with Frontier in late January. I'll keep the Council posted on developments.

NEW BUSINESS / PROJECTED ISSUES & PROJECTS

- ✓ C.D.B.G. DESIGNATION OF AUTHORIZATION (Resolution)
 - Included with tonight's agenda is the City's designation of authorized signatories for management of the CDBG Funds. The County MPO requires periodic updates in accordance with HUD rules. This resolution continues Juanita, Mary Jo and I as the City's designated officers.
- ✓ FINAL SITE PLAN APPROVAL, CORNERSTONE ADDITION (Resolution)

Included with tonight's packet is a request for final site plan approval of a 12,175 sf addition to Cornerstone Baptist Church. The entire packet of reviews and approvals can be found on the CD. I have included a copy of 17" x 24" drawings in the packet for ease of review. The applicant has met all of the requirements of the ordinance and our consultants. Mr. Zettel recommends approval.

✓ F.A.N.G. ANNUAL DUES INVOICE (Resolution)

Included with tonight's packet is an invoice from FANG for annual 2012-2013 dues membership, in the amount of \$7,850.60. It was billed in late October and we've been sitting on it, as we usually do, until late in our fiscal year (June). At the annual FANG meeting in mid January, the board voted to return all of the members annual dues based on seizures and forfeitures from the previous year. It's sad to say, but apparently there's no lack of a recession in the illicit narcotics trade. At any rate, we have to pay the invoice before the dues can be refunded. I have a resolution to appropriate payment with tonight's agenda.

Five Year Parks & Recreation Plan

(Presentation)

Doug Schultz from ROWE Professional Services made a brief presentation outlining the Five Year Parks & Recreation Plan.

Public Hearing Open:

Councilmember Porath asked if Mr. Schultz generally works on these types of plans. Mr. Porath was advised that he does. Mr. Porath asked if it would present a problem that the

parks are perceived as County parks rather than City parks. Mr. Schultz stated that it would be a benefit that the City parks have more of a regional draw.

Councilmember Shumaker asked what the cost would be to maintain the trailway year round. Mr. Schultz stated that he would have to figure the exact cost; there are many variables.

City Manager Bueche spoke about the variables for maintenance costs. Mr. Bueche stated that he is unsure if the recurring maintenance costs are significant.

Mr. Shumaker asked if the State and Federal Government will be taking into consideration that the park is being used more as a regional park and non city residents are allowed to use it. Mr. Schultz explained again that it would be a benefit. Mr. Shumaker asked if City Manager Bueche had applied for County Park grant money in the past. Mr. Bueche stated that he has but has not received a good response.

Councilmember Hicks asked if there is any better opportunity to receive the grant if replacing something that is already there. Mr. Schultz advised that there are different types of grants that can be utilized. Ms. Hicks asked if the City could work with another municipality to receive grants.

Mayor Pro-Tem Abrams spoke about the proposed trail at Winshall Park, asking what the rationale was for it being there. Mr. Abrams stated that he thinks it will provide access for kids to hang out down there. Mr. Bueche stated that the park is highly used by walkers who have created their own trail in that area.

Mayor Krueger asked if the trails in Swartz Creek connected to any other trails, and if not are there any plans to connect them. Mr. Bueche stated that it is set up to adjust and match up at some points. Mr. Krueger asked if there was a plan to replace some of the Ash trees that were cut down. Mr. Schultz stated that there was no plan but that it would be addressed. Mr. Krueger stated that the Swartz Creek Chamber of Commerce has volunteered to pay for some of the trees. Mr. Svrcek stated that there are a lot of service groups in and around the City that also want to volunteer services.

Public Comments:

Jim Florence, 4296 Springbrook, stated that very little had been accomplished from the last 5 year park plan until last year when the local service groups supported the renovation of a pavilion. Mr. Florence stated that the Park Board's plan is to get together in February and go through the plan and contact different service organizations and volunteer groups to take on different aspects of renovations and improvements. Mr. Florence stated that the City received a grant for trees last year. Mr. Florence stated that Pat Williams, the writer of the grant, is now a member of the Park Board and is expected to apply for more grants this year.

Mr. Krueger suggested that individuals in the community also be utilized as volunteers.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That MEIJER, INC., a Michigan corporation ("Grantor"), of 2929 Walker Avenue, N.W., Grand Rapids, Michigan 49544, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar and other good and valuable consideration paid to it by THE CITY OF SWARTZ CREEK, whose address is 8083 Civic Drive, Swartz Creek, Michigan 48473 ("Grantee"), does hereby grant, convey and release to said Grantee, a permanent nonexclusive pedestrian walkway easement (the "Walkway") over, across, under and through the following parcels of land situated in the City of Swartz Creek, County of Genesee, Michigan and described as follows:

Tax Parcel No. 58-36-100-001

The West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 36, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, Except that part thereof lying South of the North line of Highway M-78 (I-69 Freeway), as set forth in Deed Liber 1355, Page 201 Genesee County Records and further described as: Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Section 36; thence North 89 degrees 14 minutes 47 seconds East, 1299.70 feet along the North line of said Section 36; thence South 00 degrees 01 minute 18 seconds East 2112.80 feet along the occupied West 1/8 line to its intersection with the North right of way of I-69 Freeway; thence South 87 degrees 12 minutes 50 seconds West, 673.90 feet along the North right of way of I-69 Freeway; thence North 71 degrees 28 minutes 24 seconds West, 543.06 feet along the Northerly right of way of I-69 Freeway; thence North 00 degrees 04 minutes 10 seconds West, 299.01 feet; thence South 89 degrees 55 minutes 50 seconds West, 35.00 feet; thence North 00 degrees 04 minutes 10 seconds West, 528.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 55 minutes 50 seconds West, 75.00 feet to the West line of Section 36; thence North 00 degrees 04 minutes 10 seconds West, 1129.03 feet along the West line of Section 36 to the Point of Beginning.

A parcel of land located in the Northwest quarter of Section 36, Town 7 North, Range 5 East, City of Swartz Creek, Genesee County, Michigan further described as: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of Section 36, Town 7 North, Range 5 East; thence along the west line of said Section, South 00° 04' 10" East, 1283.31 feet; thence North 89° 55' 50" East, 75.00 feet, to the easterly right of way line of Morrish Road and the point of beginning; thence South 10° 09' 03" East, 60.82 feet; thence Southerly 27.14 feet along the arc of a curve to the left with a radius of 99.00 feet, a central angle of 15° 42' 27", and a chord which bears South 18° 00' 17" East, 27.06 feet; thence South 25° 51' 30" East, 93.60 feet; thence Southeasterly 49.06 feet along the arc of a curve to the right with a radius of 109.00 feet, a central angle of 25° 47' 21", and a chord which bears South 12° 57' 50" East, 48.65 feet; thence South 00° 04' 10" East, 201.88 feet; thence South 86° 27' 52" West, 10.02 feet; thence North 00° 04' 10" West, 202.48 feet; thence Northerly 44.56 feet along the arc of a curve to the left with a radius of 99.00 feet, a central angle of 25° 47' 21", and a chord which bears North 12° 57' 50" West, 44.19 feet; thence North 25° 51' 30" West, 93.60 feet; thence Northwesterly 29.88 feet along the arc of a curve to the right with a radius of 109.00 feet, a central angle of 15° 42' 27", and a chord which bears North 18° 00' 17" West, 29.79 feet; thence North 10° 09' 03" West, 4.58 feet to said easterly right of way line; thence along said easterly right of way line, North 00° 04' 10" West, 57.13 feet, to the point of beginning. Containing 0.093 acres, more or less.

The Easement Area is located approximately as depicted on attached Exhibit A.

Grantee acknowledges that this easement is subject to all existing easements, restrictions and encumbrances affecting the Easement Area. Grantee further acknowledges that Grantor may grant other encumbrances over the Easement Area which do not interfere with the uses permitted to Grantee hereunder. Grantor and its lessees, successors or assigns may use the Easement Area for parking and access to its property and for any other purpose which would not unreasonably interfere with the uses permitted to Grantee hereunder, including, without limitation, landscaping, construction of driveways, curbing, paved parking areas and related improvements; provided that no buildings shall be constructed within the Easement Area.

Grantee agrees that in the event the Grantor desires to relocate the Walkway to any other location on Grantor's Property, Grantee will cooperate with Grantor in connection with such relocation, provided that the new area can be effectively utilized by Grantee for its purposes, and further provided that any such relocation requested by Grantor shall be performed by Grantee at Grantor's expense and in accordance with all of Grantee's requirements for construction of similar municipal facilities. In the event of any such relocation, the parties agree to amend the legal description and exhibit attached hereto, as required, in order to reflect of record the new location of the Walkway.

To the extent not otherwise prohibited or limited by law, Grantee agrees to defend, indemnify and save harmless Grantor, its parent, subsidiary and affiliated entities and their respective officers, directors, shareholders, partners, agents and employees (hereafter collectively "Related Parties"), from and against any and all liability or claim thereof (including but not limited to reasonable actual attorney fees and costs) whether for injury to persons, including death, or damage to property, which may be imposed upon, incurred by or asserted against Grantor or its Related Parties: (i) allegedly or actually arising in connection with or resulting from the operation and/or use of the Walkway; (ii) arising out of any default by Grantee under this Easement; or (iii) arising out of any negligent act or omission to act by Grantee, its agents, employees, contractors or subcontractors. The foregoing indemnity from Grantee shall not extend to liability resulting from the negligence or willful misconduct of Grantor or its Related Parties.






