✓ PARK RESERVATION WAIVER REQUESTS (Business Item)

There is a park reservation waiver request being sought by a non-profit group. The group is identified as Bethany Christian Services Inc., a Section 501(c)(3) nonprofit. They seek waiver of the \$70 standard pavilion fee for pavilion number 2 in Abrams for July 20th, a Saturday. They have not applied for a waiver before.

Per the park rules: "fees may be waived in full if reservations by a non-profit are found to result in a public benefit directly or if proceeds from the reserved event are found to be a benefit to the city."

The reservation and statement are attached. While the purpose of the nonprofit is no-doubt a benefit to the region, the direct benefit offered appears unrelated and in direct response to the requirements to have a fee waived. If council recalls, the initial dilemma encountered was the charging for fees to groups that were using the park primarily to perform a service within the park (e.g. staining the playscape, providing direct services to residents, or coordination meetings/picnics for park related groups/fundraisers).

I doubt the council wishes to split hairs over this application for a \$70 waiver, given that it does appear to meet the stated qualifications. However, I see the potential trend towards waivers for all groups that can offer even the smallest of park improvements during their stay. For the record, a large proportion of pavilion use is by churches, schools, and other non-profits.

The fees collected help offset weekend overtime, material, and vehicle expense for waste collection, inspections, and bathroom upkeep services that our staff provide directly.
