## IX. COMPLETING APPLICATION

<u>GENERAL:</u> Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, at least 1 day's notice is required. Permit number and job address required.

<u>PERMIT EXPIRATION:</u> A permit remains valid provided work is progressing & inspections are requested & conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 6 months after issuance or if work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencement. A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested/conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection Cancelled permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.
